1. ATTENDEES

9 delegates from Unite, 3 delegates from PCS, 2 delegates from NUJ, 1 delgate from USDAW.

2. APOLOGIES:

The Meeting opened with a silence for the 4 workers killed in Avonmouth.

- **4. MATTERS ARISING:** Workers Memorial Day A UNITE branch had offered funding to upgrade the plaque. Airbus responders won their dispute.

5. REPORTS

Glos Strikes – Sheila reported the Key Workers Summit was good with a turnout of 30, members were encouraged to attend. Ian reported on a planning meeting. Barry Faulkner from UNITE spoke on organizing in covid, the next summit is 21st January with workshops on organizing in covid and rights at work. A delegate from PCS said this is an excellent initiative which we must support.

Unemployed Workers Centre – A delegate from PCS reported that existing centres had been looked at, demo planned for February, Planning meeting 4th January.

SWTUC – Simon Crew reported on the save Union Learn campaign and plans for Tolpuddle. Several delegates opposed plans to charge attendance at Tolpuddle.

University Court – Simon Crew reported on a virtual meeting.

NUJ – A NUJ delegate advised of several employers bullying their staff to work during furlough. Another NUJ delegate reported on threats from extreme right wing groups. PCS – A delgate from PCS advised the petition for a parliamentary debate was successful but he was shocked that the minister refused to take interventions.

The delegate from USDAW advised on the violence to shop workers petition.
